Birds pass this day light air and calm course N.W. by N. by compass Middle part strong breeze latter part light breeze from S. to S.W. course N.W. by compass saw nothing for Enos there 24 hours

Remarks On Board Monday Feb 14th 1839

Birds pass this day light breeze from S.W. course N.W. weather thick and rainy Middle part the same latter part pleasant and nothing for Enos this day

Remarks On Board Tuesday Feb 15th 1839

Birds pass light air from S.W. course N.W. at 4 P.M. wind changes to N. and rain begins N.W. Middle part calm latter part light air from S.W. to N.W. heading for N.W. by compass saw nothing of remarks for Enos there 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednesday Feb 16th 1839

Birds pass this day light air from S. to W. course N.W. by N. Middle and latter part light air from all quarters weather equally light light rain from Blackfish and porpoises for Enos this day

Remarks On Board Thursday Feb 17th 1839

Birds pass light air and calm Middle part the same latter part light breeze from N.W. to N.E. course N.W. by N. for Enos this day

Birds pass this day moderate breeze from N.W. course N.W. by N. by compass Middle part strong breeze latter part light breeze from N. by the wind to N.W. saw nothing of remarks for Enos there 24 hours

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb 20th 1839

Birds pass this day light breeze from N.W. and pleasant course N.W. by N. by compass Middle and latter part light breeze and pleasant from N.W. saw Blackfish and porpoises weather fine for Enos there 24 hours
