*First part this day fresh breeze from N. by E. off Magdalena Bay
Mounts in for white platters, pleasant, steering in for the Bay
So Enues this day Land dist 10 miles*

Remarks On Board Saturday July 30th 1839

*First part this day pleasant, steady in the Bay in company
with Bark J. Cummins at 4 P. M. came to Anchor
in 4 fathom water*

Remarks On Board Sunday July 31st 1839

This day Employers in getting off wood and spreading the outside

Remarks On Board Monday August 1st 1839

*This day all hands Employers in getting off wood and
spreading outside*

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 2^d 1839

This day all hands Employers in getting off wood

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 3^d 1839

*This day fine weather, finished getting off wood and getting
ready to sail at 1 P. M. took our Anchor and started
out of the Bay at 12 M. passed out of the passage
for Enues this day*

Remarks On Board Thursday August 4th 1839

*First part this day strong breeze from N. by E. heading
S. by E. the wind Land dist 20 miles Middle part fresh
breeze latter part the same heading N. by E. the wind for
Enues then 34 hours*

Long 114° 19' West*

Remarks On Board Friday August 5th 1839

*First part this day strong breeze from N. by E. to N. N. E. course
N. by E. compass Middle part the same latter part strong gale
from N. weather thick and squally saw nothing for
Enues then 34 hours*

Long 117° 31' West*

Remarks On Board Saturday August 6th 1839

*First part this day moderate gale from N. course N. by E. to
compass Middle and latter part the same weather foggy
So Enues then 34 hours*

Remarks On Board Sunday August 7th

*First part this day moderate gale from N. E. course N. by E. to
weather thick and foggy Middle and latter part course N. by E. to
weather foggy with a heavy swell from N. point E. N. E. passed
St. Michaels (Bark) steering I saw Blackfish for Enues then
34 hours*

*Lat 33° 39' North
Long 120° 39' West*

Remarks On Board Monday August 8th 1839

*First part this day strong breeze from E. N. E. and foggy course
N. by E. to compass Middle part the same latter part light breeze
from N. E. to E. N. E. Employers in ship duty saw nothing
for Enues then 34 hours*

*Lat 33° 39' North
Long 123° 30' West*

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 9th 1839

*First part this day moderate breeze from N. E. course N. by E. to
compass Middle part the same latter part foggy with
light rain course N. by E. wind E. N. E. saw nothing for Enues then
34 hours*

*First part this day moderate breeze from E. N. E. course N. by E. to
compass Middle part the same latter part steady N. by E. to
weather foggy for Enues this day*

*First part this day moderate breeze from E. N. E. course N. by E. to
compass Middle and latter part the same weather
thick and cloudy nothing in sight Employers in
ship duty for Enues this day*
