 First part this day light breeze from N.E. Course N. by E. of compass
 Employers turning down Middle part light breeze from E. to N.E.
 latter part light breeze from N. by E. of compass. Nothing seen
 for Enies then 24 hours
 Lat. of Obs 23. 12 North
 Long. of Obs 136. 37 West

 First part this day fresh breeze from N.E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle and latter part the same saw nothing
 for Enies then 24 hours

 First part this day fresh breeze from N.E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle part the same latter part strong breeze
 in squalls with light rain. Employers in painting gun work
 and turning piggish. Saw nothing of Enies for Enies
 then 24 hours

 Long. of Obs 141. 03 West

 First part this day fresh breeze from N.E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle part the same latter part squally with
 rain for Enies then 24 hours
 Lat. of Obs 23. 53 North
 Long. of Obs 142. 12 West

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 17th
 First part this day strong breeze from N.E. to E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle part moderate gale from
 E. by N. and squally with rain. Latter part the
 same for Enies this day

 Long. of Obs 143. 30 West

First part this day moderate gale from E. by N. Course
 N. by E. of compass. Middle part the same with heavy squalls of
 rain. Latter part the same saw nothing of Enies this day
 for Enies then 24 hours
 Lat. of Obs 22. 29 North
 Long. of Obs 148. 31 West

Remarks On Board Friday August 19th
 First part this day moderate gale from E. N.E. with squalls
 of rain. Course N. by E. of compass. Middle part the same latter
 part more moderate saw nothing of Enies for Enies
 then 24 hours
 Lat. of Obs 21. 31 North
 Long. of Obs 151. 37 West

Remarks On Board Saturday August 20th 1839
 First part this day fresh breeze from E. N.E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle and latter part the same Employers
 in ship's duty for Enies this day
 Lat. of Obs 21. 29 North
 Long. of Obs 152. 13 West

Remarks On Board Sunday August 21st 1839
 First part this day light breeze from E. N.E. Course N. by E. of
 compass. Middle and latter part light breeze from E.
 Course N. by E. of compass. Latter part squally saw nothing
 for Enies then 24 hours
 Lat. of Obs 21. 36 North
 Long. of Obs 155. 27 West

Remarks On Board Monday August 22nd 39
 First part this day fresh breeze from E. Course N. by E. of
 compass at 12 M. saw the Island of Oahu (Berm)
 of Oahu at 1 M. Dist 80 miles at 3 P.M. saw the Island
 of Maui bearing N. by E. Dist 30 miles N. by E. Course
 at dark shortened sails. Middle part steered N. by E.
 for the Island of Oahu latter part the Island
 in sight steering N. by E. of the chain and got into
 anchor off the Boat for Enies then 24 hours
