First part this day fresh breeze from N.E. steering by the compass
 to E.S.E. & compass middle part the same latter part light
 wind from N. to E. weather squally saw porpoise 1st
 (Ends then 24 hours) Lat & Obs 35° 20' North
 Long & Chem 135° 48' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday Oct 5th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N. course (E.S.E.) & compass
 middle and latter part the same course (E.S.E.)
 compass weather pleasant saw nothing of remarks (Emplyes in
 ships out for ends then 24 hours) Lat & Obs 34° 45' North
 Long & Chem 131° 28' West

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 6th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.N.E. & the winds to E.
 & compass weather pleasant middle and latter part the
 same saw nothing for ends Lat & Obs 33° 24' North
 Long & Chem 129° 04' West

Remarks On Board Friday Oct 7th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.N.E. to N.E. heading
 (E.S.E.) & the winds weather cloudy and cold
 middle and latter part the same saw nothing of remarks
 for ends then 24 hours Lat & Obs 32° 34' North
 Long & Chem 126° 36' West

Remarks On Board Saturday Oct 8th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.N.E. steering by the
 winds to E. weather hazy nothing in sight middle and
 latter part light air from N.N.W. course (E.S.E.) compass middle
 and latter part the same saw nothing of remarks (Emplyes in
 ships out for ends then 24 hours) Lat & Obs 31° 43' North
 Long & Chem 124° 31' West

Remarks On Board Sunday Oct 9th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N. course (E.S.E.) & compass
 middle and latter part the same course light
 for ends then 24 hours Lat & Obs 30° 38' North
 Long & Chem 123° 04' West

 middle part the same latter part strong breeze from N. course
 (E.S.E.) saw nothing of remarks (Emplyes in ships for ends
 then 24 hours) Lat & Obs 29° 08' North
 Long & Chem 118° 39' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday Oct 12th 1839

First part this day strong breeze from N.N.W. course (E.S.E.) compass
 to S. P. M. saw the Islands of Guadalupe bearing (E.S.E.) N.
 & compass dist 30 miles at 6. took in sails and headed by the
 winds to N. P. M. middle part the same latter part 2 boats in fishing
 for ends then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 13th 1839

First part ship lying off and on 2 boats in fishing at 5 P.M.
 took up the boats and steered off (E.S.E.) & compass middle
 part the same latter part pleasant (E.S.E.) weather pleasant
 saw nothing for ends then 24 hours Lat & Obs 28° 15' North
 Long & Chem 117° 14' West

Remarks On Board Friday Oct 14th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N. course (E.S.E.) & compass
 middle part the same latter part steamer (E.S.E.) & compass
 saw nothing of remarks (Emplyes in repairing) (Sails
 for ends then 24 hours) Lat & Obs 27° 15' North
 Long & Chem 115° 25' West

Remarks On Board Saturday Oct 15th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N. course (E.S.E.) weather
 hazy middle part steamer (E.S.E.) latter part steamer (E.S.E.)
 nothing of remarks in ships out for ends then 24 hours
 Lat & Obs 26° 43' North
 Long & Chem 114° 30' West
