Remarks On Board Sunday Oct 16th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N.W. course S.E. by compass
middle part light breeze from N.W. latter part steady off
N.E. weather clear and pleasant nothing in sight but kelp
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 36° 14' N Long 124° 23' West

Remarks On Board Monday Oct 17th 1839

First part this day light breeze and pleasant steering S.E. by compass
middle part steady S.E. latter part steady E. by compass
nothing to be seen (Employees in ships out about 2 miles)
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 34° 57' N Long 123° 57' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday Oct 18th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N.W. and pleasant course
E. by compass middle part heading to N.W. latter part
more ship's flood in E. for the land saw black fields
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 32° 10' N Long 122° 17' West

Remarks On Board Wednesday Oct 19th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.W. heading N.E. by
the wind saw the land Cape Lopez Dist 30 miles middle
part heading to N.W. latter part heading to N.E. saw
nothing for Endeavour this day
Lat 24° 18' N Long 121° 46' West

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 20th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N.W. and pleasant heading
to N.W. middle part heading to N.W. latter part heading
to N.E. weather clear and wind strong saw nothing
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 24° 35' N Long 121° 07' West

Remarks On Board Friday Oct 21st 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.W. heading E. saw
Gulf of California and the land middle heading N.W. latter
part heading E. N.E. saw nothing of remarks
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 24° 09' N Long 120° 19' West

First part this day fresh breeze steering E. N.E. the land in sight
at 6 o'clock off shore middle part the same latter part tack
to N.W. weather pleasant saw nothing of remarks
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 23° 53' N Long 119° 48' West

Remarks On Board Sunday Oct 23rd 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from S.W. heading N.E. by the
wind saw the land to N.W. middle part heading to S.W. latter part
tack to N.W. saw Gulf of California lower part for Endeavour
weather pleasant for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 23° 48' N Long 118° 48' West

Remarks On Board Monday Oct 24th 1839

First part pleasant steering E. by S. wind N.W. land in sight
middle part heading of the wind to S.W. by S. latter part steady
off E. by compass saw nothing of remarks Employes in ships out
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 23° 33' N Long 118° 07' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday Oct 25th 1839

First part this day fresh breeze from N.W. steering E. by N. the
land at 6 P.M. headed to off shore to N.W. middle part
light breeze passing a steamer brand down the coast latter
steering E. by E. for Endeavour this day
Lat 23° 09' N

Remarks On Board Wednesday Oct 26th 1839

First part this day light breeze from N.W. steering E. lower reef
for Gulf of California Dist 30 miles middle part heading
to N.W. latter part steering in for the land Cape St Lucas
for Endeavour this day

Remarks On Board Thursday Oct 27th 1839

First part strong breeze from N.W. lying off and on Cape St
Lucas at 10 o'clock went ashore at 4 P.M. the boat off and
stowed the wind on N.W. middle and latter part fresh
gale from N.W. looking fine light sails saw nothing
for Endeavour than 24 hours
Lat 21° 39' N Long 119° 19' West
