Remarks On Board Sunday Dec 4th 1839

First part this day fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.E.
 at 8 P.M. saw a large sperm whale spout to some distance
 however the boats that could not come up with it whale
 at dark took up the boats heading to N.W. S. judd
 and latter part light air saw nothing of remarks for
 (Ends then 24 hours) Lat 18° 12' North
 Long 113° 21' West

Remarks On Board Monday Dec 5th 1839

First part this day calm at 4 P.M. light air from N. heading
 N.W. S. judd pass calm latter part light air from
 N. heading N.W. S. judd (Blackfish however got one for
 (Ends then 24 hours) Lat 18° 18' North
 Long 113° 21' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday Dec 6th 1839

First part this day light breezes from N. heading N.W. S. judd
 the wind shifted pass to N.E. saw the boats
 to N.E. latter part strong breezes saw nothing of
 remarks for Ende then 24 hours Lat 18° 46' North
 Long 113° 31' West

First part this day strong breezes from N.W. heading
 to N.W. S. judd pass the same latter part to N.E.

 breezes from N.W. heading N.E. by the same saw nothing
 of remarks for Ende then 24 hours Lat 19° 22' North
 Long 113° 29' West

Remarks On Board Sunday Dec 11th 1839

First part this day fresh breezes from N.W. heading N.E.
 saw in sight judd and the same judd pass to N.W. S. judd
 latter part from N.W. heading N.W. S. judd saw nothing
 for Ende then 24 hours Lat 19° 48' North
 Long 113° 31' West

Remarks On Board Monday Dec 12th 1839

First part this day light breezes from N. heading N.W. S. judd
 compass judd and latter part the same (Employed
 ships and saw nothing of remarks for Ende
 then 24 hours) Lat 20° 08' North
 Long 113° 31' West

Remarks On Board Tuesday Dec 13th 1839

First part this day light breezes from N. heading to the point
 to N.W. S. judd and latter part the same saw nothing
 for Ende then 24 hours Lat 20° 45' North

Remarks On Board Wednesday Dec 14th 1839

First part this day light breezes from N. heading N.W. S. judd
 at 6 P.M. judd to N.E. judd pass the same
 latter part judd to N.W. S. judd saw nothing
