First pass this day light breeze from S.W. heading S.E.
by the wind. Middle pass calm latter part light air from
S. steering in for Payta the vessel 15.30 miles

Remarks On Board Thursday Feb 14th 1860

First pass this day light breeze from S.W. steering
in for the Harbour at P. Co. came to anchor at the
port of Payta in 8 fathoms of water

Remarks On Board Friday Feb 17th

This day (Employees) Blacking put fire the water
the shore in sight for P. Co. this day

Remarks On Board Saturday Feb 18th

This day one water in there for P. Co. the other
Employees on Board

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb 19th

This day one water in there for P. Co.

Remarks On Board Monday Feb 20th 1860

First this day one Board ship P. Co. for
waiting for a clearance from the Consul Ship
2 hours

Remarks On Board Tuesday Feb 21st

First pass ship ready for fire waiting to clear the ship

Remarks On Board Wednesday Feb 22nd

This day all hands on Board ship 2 hours
and took them on Board waiting to clear the ship

Remarks On Board Thursday Feb 23rd

This day all on Board except the Capt.
waiting to clear the ship

Remarks On Board Friday Feb 24th 1860

First pass with all hands on board took pass Anchors and
steved to pass at 6 P. Co. Payta Head S. E. Dist 15.30
middle and latter part light air heading N. E. saw nothing
for P. Co. this day

Remarks On Board Saturday Feb 25th 1860

First pass this day light air and calm heading N. E. by compass
middle part light air from S. E. steering N. E. by compass latter part
wind S. lower N. E. Employees on ship Auto saw nothing
of remarks for P. Co. this day

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb 26th 1860

First pass this day light breeze from S. E. steering N. E. by
compass saw Blackfish middle part light breeze latter part
the flames for P. Co. this day

Remarks On Board Monday Feb 27th 1860

First pass this day light breeze from N. E. course N. E. by N.
middle part light air from N. E. latter part the same
saw nothing of remarks for P. Co. this day 24 hours

Remarks On Board Tuesday Feb 28th 1860

First pass this day calm and clear nothing seen middle
and latter part light air from S. E. course N. E. by N. for
P. Co. this day 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednesday Feb 29th

First pass this day light air from S. E. course N. E. by N.
saw porpoises middle and latter part light breeze from
S. E. and rain saw nothing of remarks this day for
P. Co. this day 24 hours
