 to E. spoke (Bark) (Saw 4000 Sperm saw
 the land for miles then 24 hours Sailed by Obs 111 North

First part this day light air and calm heading E. N. E.
 compass Middle part calm latter part light air from
 N. E. heading N. N. W. saw a sail and the land
 for miles then 24 hours No Observation
