Sails pass this day, breeze from N.E. sent to the rock, for first. Noiselle and latter pass heading for N.E. since light found the current setting N.W. 3 knots per hour then 30 hours. Lat 1. 37 North

Remarks On Board Thursday April 19th 1860

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. heading to N. N.W. and Monmans Island. Breeze N.W. 10 miles. Noiselle pass calm latter pass fair. A school of sperm whales going E. N.E. it being calm could not come up with them. Culpes Island in sight the boats still in chase of the phalar ships put off sight of boats. Steward off duty.

Remarks On Board Friday April 20th

Sails pass this day, calm the sails in chase of the phalar ships pass the stern of Noiselle and latter then planted to look for the ships at 7 got to the ships and took up the boats. Noiselle and latter pass light breeze from N.E. 10 steering E. by N. for Endeavour this day. Lat 1. 33 North

Remarks On Board Saturday April 21st

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. steering E. by N. saw Culpes and Monmans Islands. Noiselle and latter pass at sail in sight saw sperm whales lower the boats in chase for Endeavour then 24 hours. Steward off duty. Culpes N.W. 20 miles

Remarks On Board Sunday April 22^d

Sails pass this day, calm the boats in chase struck 3 and lower them to the ships at dusk at day light boats cutting at 12. Breeze and clear up the winds per Endeavour this day. Lat 1. 21 North

Remarks On Board Monday April 23^d

Sails pass this day, calm. Employed in clearing up decks. Noiselle and latter pass. Employed in boiling. Saw nothing of remarks per Endeavour this day. Steward off duty with penicillin.

Sails pass this day, light breeze from E. by E. heading N. by the wind. Noiselle pass the same latter pass light breeze from N. by the wind. Lat 1. 37 North. Steward off duty.

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. heading E. by E. by the wind. Noiselle and latter pass the same and nothing of remarks per Endeavour then 24 hours. Lat 1. 33 North. Steward off duty.

Remarks On Board Thursday April 26th

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. heading E. by E. by the wind. Noiselle pass calm latter pass strong breeze from N.E. heading E. by E. compass employed. Culpes and latter pass nothing of remarks per Endeavour this day. Lat 1. 31 North. Steward off duty.

Remarks On Board Friday April 27th 1860

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. by the wind to E. Noiselle and latter pass fresh breeze heading E. by E. Employed plotting course. Life in the morning latter pass nothing of remarks per Endeavour this day. Steward off duty. Lat 1. 31 North.

Remarks On Board Saturday April 28th

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N. heading E. by E. by the wind. Noiselle and latter pass the same. Employed plotting course. Life per Endeavour this day. Lat 1. 17 North. Steward off duty.

Remarks On Board Sunday April 29th

Sails pass this day, light breeze from N.E. heading E. by E. Noiselle pass the same latter pass heading E. by E. by the wind. Weather pleasant. Saw nothing of remarks per Endeavour then 24 hours. Lat 1. 33 North. Steward off duty.
