First part this day light breeze from N.W. heading P.P.E. of the
line and blackfishes got 4. Middle part taken to N. latter
part taken to P.P.E. A part in light to E. for Corde this day
Steward off duty. Lat 3. 14 South

Remarks On Board Friday May 25th 1860

First part this day fresh breeze heading P.P.E. saw four sail
and the land. Middle part calm later part strong breeze
heading off shore. Employed (Boiling) Blackfish saw the
and 2. sail for Corde then 3.4 hours
Lat 3. 42 South

Remarks On Board Saturday May 26th

First part this day strong breeze heading N.W. taken to P.E.
at 6 P.M. taken off shore to N.W. Middle part taken to
E.P.E. latter part the same saw Cape Blanco bearing P. 24
Middle sail for Corde this day Lat 3. 53 South
Steward off duty

Remarks On Board Sunday May 27th 1860

First part this day strong breeze heading P.E. at 6 P.M.
taken off shore to N.W. Middle part heading P.M. latter
part taken to E. 3.4 sail in light and the land ship weathering
up for Bay to Corde then 4 hours
Lat 4. 36 South

Remarks On Board Monday May 28th

First part this day strong breeze heading E.P.E. for the land at
6 P.M. taken off shore to N.W. Middle part lying off and
the latter part strong in for Bay

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 29th 1860

First part this day strong breeze heading in for Bay
at 3 P.M. came to anchor in 8 fathoms water

Wednesday May 30th

This day Employed ship duty all hands On
board for Corde this day

Remarks On Board Thursday May 31st 1860

First part this day Employed painting but since one watch on
the liberty for Corde the charges Stewards and Mains fore
for Corde this day

Remarks On Board Friday June 1st 1860

First part this day one watch on the liberty the latter
part getting ready for the ship the Mains and A. Steward
ship ready for for Corde then day

Remarks On Board Saturday June 2^d 1860

First part this day with all hands on board took up the
one stores put in Bay heading N.W. Middle part the same latter
part strong breeze course N.W. N. compass Employed in ship
duty for Corde this day Lat 4. 33 South

Remarks On Board Sunday June 3^d 1860

First part this day fresh breeze from P.E. steering N.W. N. compass
Middle part the same latter course N.W. N. part 4 sail and
the latter part strong from E. for Corde then 4 hours
Lat 4. 09 South

Remarks On Board Monday June 4th 1860

First part this day fresh breeze from P. steering N.W. N. compass
Middle part lying back heading to S.W. latter part strong off N.
part nothing of remarks for Corde this day Lat 4. 41 South
Long 83. 23 West

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 5th 1860

First part this day light breeze from P.E. steering N.W. compass
Middle part lying back heading E. latter part strong at N.
compass saw pinbacks and propellers for Corde
then 24 hours Lat 4. 50 South
Long 84. 52 West
