First part this day strong trade heading to N. E. at 3 P.M. saw 1 specimen Whales lowered the boats at dusk struck one at 8 foot. him along side at daylights boats cutting at 8 finished hull stored to N.W. for 24 hours

Long of Obs 86. 34 West

Remarks On Board Thursday August 9th

First part this day fresh trade heading N. E. at this time employed sailing. Middle part the same trade part finished sailing. Ship of the wind to N. E. saw nothing of remark for 24 hours

Long of Obs 86. 34 West

Remarks On Board Friday August 10th

First part this day fresh trade and ship of the wind to N. E. part of the day middle and latter part the same for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 54 North

Remarks On Board Saturday August 11th

First part this day light trade ship of the wind to N. at 4 P.M. saw 1 specimen Whales lowered the boats in chase at 5 P.M. struck a large whale for him put up a board at dusk and held to him till night at daylights he turned up and took him along side latter part employed in cutting for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 50 North

Remarks On Board Sunday August 12th

First part employed cutting at dusk finished cutting the body ship of the wind all ships to sails in sight. Middle part finished cutting and stored the boards for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 54 North

Remarks On Board Monday August 13th

First part this day strong trade at 1 P.M. saw 1 whale lowered the boats struck 2 at night took them along side employed sailing latter part finished cutting 2 sails in sight one cutting for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 50 North

Remarks On Board Tuesday August 14th

First part this day strong trade ship of the wind to N. E. spoke bark of 1 specimen middle and latter part employed sailing for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 50 North

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 15th 1860

First part this day light trade and sailing employed sailing spoke bark of 1 specimen middle and latter part finished sailing for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 50 North
Long of Obs 84. 32 West

Remarks On Board Thursday August 16th

First part this day light trade heading N. E. employed in stowing down 2 sails in sight to windward middle part the same latter part to N. employed in ship cut for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 54 North

Remarks On Board Friday August 17th 1860

First part this day fresh trade and sailing employed stowing down 2 sails in sight ship heading N. E. latter part to the N. of compass weather pleasant for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 58 North
Long of Obs 84. 31 West

Remarks On Board Saturday August 18th

First part this day strong trade heading N. employed in stowing down 2 sails in sight middle part the same latter part employed stowing down weather pleasant for 24 hours
Lat of Obs 1. 53 North
Long of Obs 86. 14 West

Remarks On Board Sunday August 19th

First part this day fresh trade heading N. E. employed in stowing down 2 sails in sight bark heading N. E. to N. E. middle and latter part to the wind to N. E. saw nothing of remark for 24 hours

Long of Obs 87. 27 West
