All hands employed in taking tarpaulins on board and getting ready for sail for Cores this day

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 16th 1860

First part this day ship ready for sea look 2. Now from the island to work then passage until the ship reaches port or until they can get a chance to go to some other ship that is in want of. Very little part took our anchoring and started to sea heading E. N. E. at 12. Mr. Mount put on P. M. 4. M. 20 miles due for Cores then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 17th 1860

First part this day light breeze and pleasant heading E. Spoke Bark J. A. Perkins 38. South but 1000. Spoke Muelle. And later part heading to E. N. E. from nothing of remarks for Cores then 24 hours

First part this day fresh breeze and slightly heading E. N. E. Muelle and later part the same heading E. N. E. compass weather pleasant and nothing of remarks employed in ship duty for Cores then 24 hours

First part this day fresh breeze and pleasant steering N. N. E. compass Spoke Bark Muelle 10 knots per 900 Spoke Muelle and later part pleasant same nothing of remarks for Cores then 24 hours

First part this day light breeze and blue weather steering N. E. Muelle part light aback later part heading to N. N. E. compass employed in taking in rigging for Cores then 24 hours

First part this day fresh breeze heading N. Spoke Bark Franklin Capt. J. Perkins Muelle and later part same nothing for Cores then 24 hours

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 26th 1860

First part this day fresh breeze ship to the point to N. A. sail in ship for N. Muelle part steering to N. E. later part the weather slightly with light rain same nothing of remarks for Cores then 24 hours
