 Long 52.16

43 Fri June 7th 1878
 Prev 24 Hours Steering to N with a
 Light wind from S W to Long &
 Blackfish No ends Lat 30.10
 Long 52.30

44 Sat June 8th 1878
 Prev 24 Hours Light air from S.W. &
 Hazy Lat first Very thick in Dark
 Steering to S Sundown Calm so ends
 Lat 31.46
 Long 52.15

45 Sun June 9th 1878
 Prev 24 Hours Light air from S.W. Daylight
 Lat bottom by French Bayou America
 de Sahali Bound to New York it
 has been thick fog all Day
 so ends Lat 31.27
 Long 52.17

 Grampus one so ends Lat 32.32

 Prev 24 Hours Light air from S. S. E
 Steering to East every thing looking
 Dead so ends Lat 32.35
 Long 50.45

49 Thu June 13th 1878
 Prev 24 Hours Light air from S. S. E
 Steering to East in hairpin Log
 Sundown tack in Sail to S.W
 so ends Lat 32.46
 Long 49.29

50 Fri June 14th 1878
 Prev 24 Hours weather very Squally &
 thick & Calm Am here about 10
 whales of Ice been going quick
 to W by S. Scaused but could not
 get in Dead of the whales came
 on board Spurred 3 times Sundown
 when going quick run to Sails &
 Bitten Squid so ends Lat 32.37
 Long 50.25
