Waved Long 51" 33 Salt 31" 51
Our Long Long 50" 44

On July 6th 1878

- 72 When 24 Hours Brisk Breeze from W.S.W
& Squally under to Rich & bab. Gib
So Ends Salt
Long

On July 7th 1878

- 73 When 24 Hours Brisk Breeze from N.S.W
& Squally & a plenty of rain under
to Rich So Ends Salt
Long

On July 8th 1878

- 74 When 24 Hours Brisk Breeze from S.W
Squally with a plenty of Rain &
Lightning Spoke the C.L. Sparks
Nothing find we see his behavior
So Ends Salt
Long

On July 9th 1878

- When 24 Hours Light air from N. &
more pleasant Daylight in Whaling
Schr C. L. Sparks Steering to S.E

17th Aug 4th

We Steered to N Wind to E 11 clock
rose Bundle of Shingles 12 1/2 clock rose
Bruncher 2 clock rose Spoke maid then
Out Sperm whaler going to West
2 clock Spoked 4 clock whole long
Side & a good one Boat chased
til Dark Come very near getting
Hold up End Salt 32" 31
Our Long by Chron 52" 16 Long 53" 00

Wed 10th 1878

- 76 When 24 Hours Light air from E
Daylight commenced Eating Whole sinking
Heavy were ship & cut to toward
Dark all in but junk to Ends

Th 11th 1878

- 77 When 24 Hours Light air from East
Set works going 2 clock Am took
in junk Dark weather Good Oil
Coming very free to Ends

On 12th 1878

- 78 When 24 Hours Light air from E.S.E
All hands employed in Cile Coaled
Down 10 clock Am So Ends
Salt 33" 20
Long 51" 51

On 13th 1878

- 79 When 24 Hours Light air from S.E.E
Worked Down all of our coal Cile
Coaled Down 10 clock Am So Ends
Salt 33" 22
Long 51" 49
