be the Brig D. A. Small Bound  
home with 650 blr Spinn sent  
letters by them I asked on  
board at 11 clock to Ende found  
our Longitude to be 70 miles to  
East of him  
Lat 32. 42  
Long 42. 42

On Aug 16th 1878  
113 First part of three 24 hours Calm  
middle 7 last part Light air  
from N. E. Brig D. A. Small went  
out of site at 9 Clock AM for  
home in to more sails bound  
to South to Ende Lat 32. 50  
Long 42. 09

Sa Aug 17th 1878  
114 First part of three 24 hours Light  
Breeze from N. W Steering to South  
Rig B. P. Sherke Steering to West  
Rig Brig Henry Brewbridge of New York  
ten months out 215 blr Spinn bound  
this in whaling the Steering to  
East with new fore to stern  
down with Breeze from N. W  
to Ende Lat 32. 25  
Long 42. 31

Su Aug 18th 1878  
115 Three 24 hours Fresh Breeze from N. W  
to N. E with rain in on sail  
to Ende Lat 32. 17  
Long 42. 04

Mon Aug 19th 1878  
116 Three 24 hours Fresh Breeze from N. W  
See nothing to Ende Lat 31. 58  
Long 41. 45

Tu Aug 20th 1878  
117 Three 24 hours Light air 7 calm sea  
nothing to Ende Lat 31. 50  
Long 41. 38
