 First part of this 24 hours Brisk Breeze
 from N.E. middle to last part more
 pleasant No Ende Lat 35.57
 Long 34.09

- 131 On Sept 3rd 1878
 First part of this 24 hours Brisk Breeze
 from N.E. & pleasant Last part
 Light air No Ende Lat 36.27
 Long 34.41

- 132 Wed Sept 4th 1878
 Then 24 hours Light air from
 Sea nothing to be done Lat 36.31
 Long 35.15

- 133 On Sept 5th 1878
 Then 24 hours Light from S.W.
 Last part squall from N.E. under
 short sail to Ende Lat 36.13
 Long 34.58

- 134 On Sept 6th 1878
 Then 24 hours Brisk Breeze from East
 in to sails All under short sail
 No Ende Lat
 Long

- 135 On Sept 7th 1878
 First part of this 24 hours Brisk
 Breeze from East 1 o'clock P.M.
 Brig Minnie Abby of Boston
 first shot to us & sciter in
 the Day Berque both steering
 to W. N. W. to Ende Lat 36.19
 Long 34.21

- 136 On Sept 8th 1878
 First part of this 24 hours Light
 air from S.E. & foggy middle
 & last part fresh breeze from
 South 3 o'clock P.M. found American
 Brig Steering West Painted white
 dot black & he amused it
 No Ende Lat 37.22
 Long 33.34

- 137 On Sept 9th 1878
 Then 24 hours Brisk Breeze from
 South Last part to heeled for red
 Bob Gib 6 o'clock in Spanish
 & white water see nothing
 more I think that we whaler
 under weather Bad Lat 37.49
 Long 32.56

- 138 On Sept 10th 1878
 First & middle part of this 24 hours
 Bad weather & shift of wind to W
 Last part more pleasant Lat 38.13
 to Ende in to sails Long 32.10
