 Looking Dark via Lots of whale
 birds & some & Blackfish & 1 surfin
 & 1 black started watch on Deck getting
 water going to Ende

Sun Dec 8th 1878

Commence with Light Breeze from
 N.W. via a plenty of Phinbacks
 & 1 black via sail & 1 black took
 C.W. Clark had nothing since
