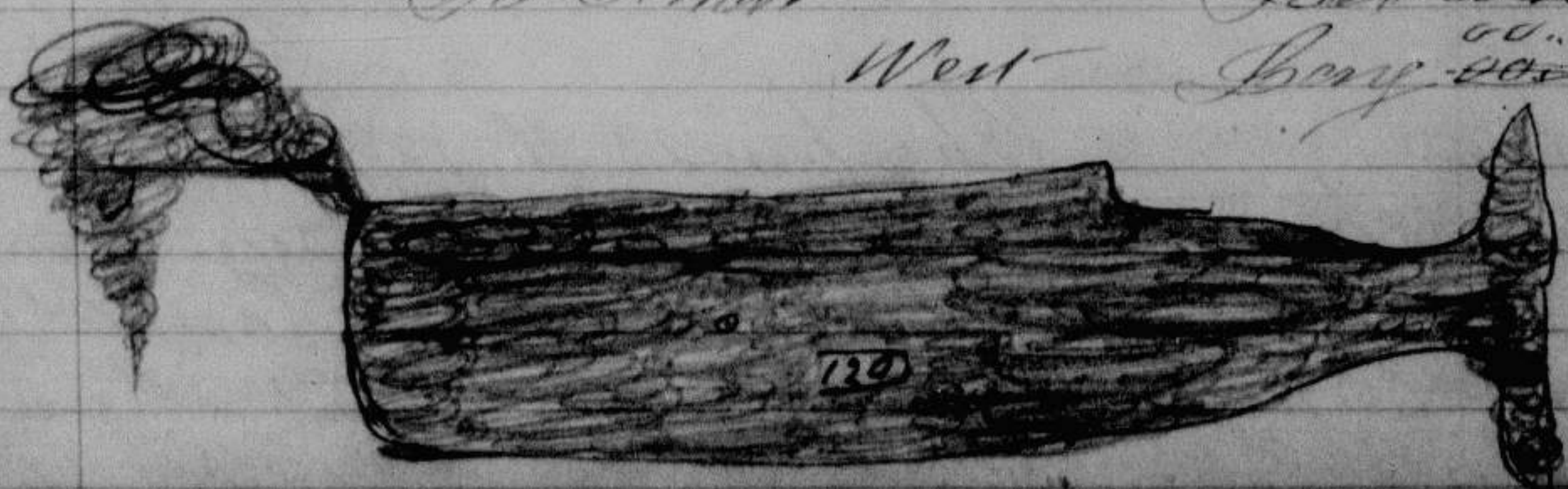


Schr G.H. Phillips On the

On Jan 24th 1879
 Commenced with Brisk Breeze from N. N. E
 Middle part Light air from North
 Last part Light air from N. West
 and fairish & water thick with
 taler. Dried Black Skin & So. Sundown
 took in Mainail Storing Co. N. E
 Wind Light So Ends Log 32.21
 West Log 2.56

On Jan 25th 1879
 Commenced with Light Breeze from N. N. W
 Middle & Last part the same and
 fairish & Grandeur & Clock all
 Still on & Half Watch So Ends
 Log 31.33
 West Log 1.31

On Jan 26th 1879
 Commenced with Light Breeze from N. W
 & Clock and large Shrim whole going
 South to N. E & six Whole Fish
 Stern of our Got Boat ready
 & Hauled Struck 12 Clock whole
 took line 3 Clock long side
 with the whole commenced cutting
 cut til Dark then raised the
 whole part for the Night
 & Clock Heavy Swell from S. W
 So Ends Log 30.00
 West Log 30.07
 00.25
 West Log 30.40



Meridian Bammel to the Coast 1879

On Jan 27th 1879
 Commenced with Heavy Swell from S
 & Light Breeze from West Day Light
 Commenced cutting & Clock rose
 & haul Shrim whole head Got
 one that Ready Hauled Struck
 & Drawed Boat Come on board
 & Clock Bare haled & let it go
 it was then. Calm took in the
 mainail set by rail with a heavy
 swell So Ends whole going given
 to N. E Log 28.58

On Jan 28th 1879
 Commenced with Light Breeze from
 West & Heavy Swell from S. 1 1/2 clock
 Am got work going & Clock on
 Still trying to End Log 29.53
 East Log 00.04

Wed Jan 29th 1879
 Commenced with Light air & Calm
 Middle & Last part the same with
 the heaviest Swell I ever see
 Stowed Down three Cask of Oil
 & Clock Still a trying out
 So Ends Log 28.30

Th Jan 30th 1879
 Commenced with Light Breeze from N. N. W
 Middle & Last part the same & a
 Heavy Swell from S. W & Clock
 Still a trying out So Ends 28.07
 West Log 00.07
