Commenced with Light Breeze from S.E.
& Calmer thick weather & rain with
Heavy Swell to ends Lat 29.28
West Long 100.46

Tu Feb 4th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
S.E. Part part Brisk Breeze
To Ends Lat 28.43
West Long 100.21

Bound to the Coast 1879

Wed Feb 5th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from S.E. &
Middle to Part part Brisk Breeze
Steering N.E. all sail out
To Ends Lat 26.44
East Long 100.13

Th Feb 6th 1879
Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S.E.
Middle to Part part the same Steering
N.E. & E in one sail to ends

Sunset took in sail to ends

& heavy Swell Middle to Part part
the same Steering N.E. & E
in Grampus one piece Bitten Squid
& a plenty of flying fish
To Ends Lat 16.06
