No Observation

Commenced with Light Breeze from S.S.W.
Middle & Last part the same
Nothing So Ends Bell 14.27
East Log 3.18

Wed Feb 12th 1879

Commenced with Light Breeze from S by W
Middle & Last part the same 4 Clock
Row sail 6 Clock Spoke Bank George
& Mary named her So Ends
Bell 14.30
East Log 1.30

Th Feb 13th 1879

Commenced with Strong Breeze from S.
Did to sail & named Brig W. H.
More all Day So Ends
Bell 14.28
East Log 2.00

Fr Feb 14th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S.
Daylight made all sail kept of
W by N for St Helena in 10
Whole ship & fair sail to anchor
Bell 14.42
East Log 1.42

of St Helena Feb 1879 55

Sa Feb 15th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze & thick
Weather 8 1/2 clock rose Spinnaker
Nearer him one Down Gang to
Windward quick Healed to & Beat
to windward Whole went out
of sight then kept of Steering
W by N for St Helena So Ends

Su Feb 16th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S
& thick Steering W by N 1/2 N
8 Clock took in sail & pitched
to So Ends Bell 16.00
West Log 4.29

Mon Feb 17th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from
S by E Steering N.W. by W 1/2 W
8 Clock rose Island of St Helena
2 Clock went on shore for Letter
W I read to 11. M. Immense
user Laying of & on head
taken 40 bl then winter So Ends

Tu Feb 18th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from
South 3 Clock came on board
& put to sea Steering N.N.E.
So Ends
Ran our Ldr Laying one
second for Day rate in
stead of 3 tents
