Commenced with Light Breeze from S.
to N. W. Rain & Squally Steering
to North in 2 Sails & Coined to
Bell 1.05
Long 22.42

Th. March 6th 1879
Commenced with Calm but fair. Light
Breeze from South in four Sails
& Blackfish Steering N. E. to Ends
Bell 1.15
Long 22.33

Fr March 7th 1879
The 24 toward Light air from all round
Calm & Calmer with a plenty Rain
Steering to N. to Ends Bell 1.31
Long 22.31

Sa March 8th 1879
The 24 toward Light air from all round
Calm & Calmer with plenty of Rain Squally & Calm
Steering to N. in 15 Sails to Ends

Commenced with Light Breeze W. with
plenty of Rain Squally & Calm in
back trader with Heavy Squall from East
in one Steamer but part not mained
with Steady Breeze from South Steering
to N. N. E. to Ends Bell 3.39

Mon March 10th 1879
Commenced with Light air from South
Middle & East part wind N. E.
in 14 Sails Blackfish & then
Sails to Ends Bell 4.58
Long 23.10

Tu March 11th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from N. E.
& pleasant Weather Middle & East part
the same in three Sails to Ends
Bell 6.08

Wed March 12th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from N. E.
Steering N. W. by N. in 2 Sails
to Ends Bell 7.28
