Sa May 31st 1879

1st Deck Commenced with Light Breeze from S. S. E. & Very Squally Air whelving Schrs Stern So Ends Fall Long

Sa June 1st 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. Very Squally & Brisk Breeze all this on board Fall Long

Mon June 2nd 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. & Very Squally with a plenty of Rain just as Sundown ran a vessel with Boat on Mast Standing So Ends Fall Long 47.00

Tu June 3rd 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from S. S. E. & Heavy with a plenty of Rain in the Peak & went on Board of Her found her Loaded with Kerosine oil & full of water got a few Small Chances & one Shroud water going Great Deck Her name was Pig & she held from Christ She was painted White Very Dangerous So Ends Fall Long

the Western Ground June 1879

Wed June 4th 1879

Commenced with Light Breeze from N. N. W. With thick Drizzly weather middle & Part past the same see nothing Whelvy So Ends

Th June 5th 1879

1st Deck Commenced with Light Breeze from N. N. W. Part past wind N. E. by E. Came out of the Gulf went to Night in fair pour Sundown So Ends Fall 31.46 Long 48.12

Fr June 6th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from N. E. middle & Part past the same in fair pour So Ends Fall 32.20 Long 49.05

Sa June 7th 1879

Commenced with Brisk Breeze from E middle & Part past the same 9 Clock rose Sail 11 Clock I went on board of Her & found her to be the Barque Jennie Cashman Capt. A. C. Long 15 Deers from Boston & got a lot of fishers So Ends Fall 33.02 Long 49.10

Su June 8th 1879

Commenced with Rain middle & Part past pleasant So Ends Fall 32.34 Long 50.12
