

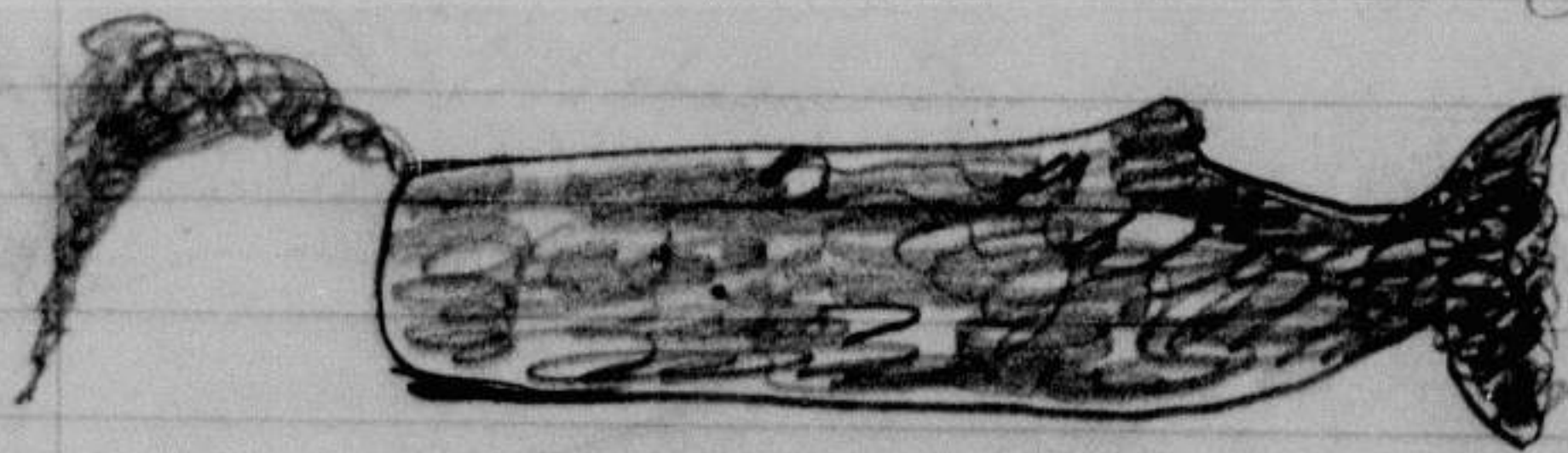
Schr. G. H. Phillips Cruising

On July 17th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
West middle & East part the same
riv one Sail So Ends Lat 32.08
Long 47.54

On July 18th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
N.W. middle & East part Calm
riv to Sailer called one Whaler
riv Blackfish So Ends Lat 31.52
Long 47.39

On July 19th 1879
Commenced with Light air from
N.W. & Calm East part wind E
So Ends Lat 31.48
Long 47.00

On July 20th 1879
Commenced with Light air from
E. S. E. riv Sail 6 Clock Am rose
Shoal of sperm whaler going
quick to S. E. 7 Clock lowered
Boats 10 Clock Long side with
Whale 2 Clock Boat came Board
Whaler went to windward out of
Site quick get ready & put in
the whale So Ends Lat 31.25
Long 47.05



On the Western Ground 1879

Mon July 21st 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
E. S. E. middle & East part the
same 9 Clock Am Boat worked
Gony 6 clock Pm fire out
riv one Sail to Ends Lat 31.17
Long 46.53

On July 22nd 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
E. S. E. middle & East part the
same riv 2 Sails & Breacher
Stowed Down 20 lbs Oil
So Ends Lat 32.18
Long 46.36

Wed July 23rd 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
E. S. E. 12 clock Sp. A. P. A. B. B. B.
Tryng (OUT) had seen whaler
Here twice Day before & Day
after we got (own Lat 32.00
& Lat 32.14 3 whaler maid 60. lbs
So Ends Lat 32.12
Long 46.98

Th July 24th 1879
Commenced with Light Breeze from
E. S. E. middle & East part the
same the Brig in site So Ends
Lat 32.10
Long 46.04
