Commenced Gentle Breeze from South, Daylight Bent our Chances & blacked & pilot and came to anchor at St. Michaels

Wed Oct 1st 1879

Commenced Light air and Rain. Upmasted and went out side of it for four men. Se Ende

Wed Oct 2nd 1879

Commenced with Light Breeze from S. S. W. 5 o'clock I went on board it was Breezing fast and I led to West Se Ende

Wed Oct 3rd 1879

Commenced Brisk Breeze from S. W. 4 o'clock took the ship to S. six one sail and Island of St. Maria & blacked in to St. Maria got from St. Maria & found our Chronometer 37 miles to East I now set 37 miles and find the rate to Steering S. S. E. for Madaria Se Ende

To Canary Islands 1879

Sa Oct 4th 1879

Commenced Gentle Breeze from S. W. Steering S. by E. Part fast Light air & Calm. Heading to S. E. Half Watch Se Ende Lat 36.31 Long 23.55

Tu Oct 5th 1879

Commenced Gentle Breeze from S. S. W. Middle of Part fast Light air Se Ende Lat 35.57 Long 23.46

Mon Oct 6th 1879

Commenced Light air & Squally from all round compass Se Ende

Tu Oct 7th 1879

Commenced Light air from S. E. & all round compass Se Ende

Wed Oct 8th 1879

Commenced Light air from South & S. E. with Light rain Se Ende Lat 32.50 Long 25.09

Th Oct 9th 1879

Commenced Light air from E. S. E. to South with Light rain. All sail on. Going to get South Se Ende Lat 32.08 Long 25.32
