Su Dec 21th 1879
 Commenced with Gentle breeze from
 N. N. W. with heavy swell
 and a plenty of fog one Whaling
 B. K. of our Lane quarter
 3 Clock rose B. K. Louisa and
 Gained her till 10 Clock She
 in 17 months Out 400 lbs all told
 the other B. K. in the Pioneer 28 months
 Out with 800 lbs all told East
 part Rain and fog No observation
