 Disagreeable So Ends Lat 32.58
 Long 6.04

Tu Dec 30th 1879
 Commenced Light Breeze from East
 With Rain and fog East port
 Light air in Whaling B.K
 6 o'clock the boat from the B.K
 came on board found him to be
 the Mary Prezier of Edgartown 38
 months out with Ice Lambach and
 500 sperm just in from Right Whaling
 Reported B.K Andrew Higgin Nothing B.K
 Albecorn Nothing and Ship Tiger Nothing
 and Hadest heard of a right Whale
 being seen this season So Ends
 Lat 32.00

 Commenced Light air from East Port
 East Brisk Breeze from N.W Daylight
 in Whaling B.K to 2.6 of Day 2 o'clock
 in Grampus Breaching So Ends
 Lat 32.28
 Long 6.18

Th Dec 1st 1880
 Commenced Brisk Breeze from N.W
 Middle and East port wind N.N.W
 3 o'clock in Whaling B.K 4 o'clock
 spoke Her B.K Mary Prezier had
 seen Nothing but one School of
 Blackfish Capt came on board
 10 o'clock Broke up Sam with
 Brisk Breeze from West So Ends
 Lat 32.58
 Long 6.09

Fr Jan 2nd 1880
 Commenced Brisk Breeze from West
 with Rain East port wind
 W. S. W with Heavy Swell from
 West in nothing now So Ends
 Lat 32.52
 Long 5.55

Sa Jan 3rd 1879
 Commenced Brisk Breeze from S.W
 East port more moderate with
 Heavy Swell from S.W See
 Nothing Whaling So Ends
 Lat 32.53
 Long 5.11
