Su May 16th 1880
 Commenced Light Breeze from S. & W
 Steaming N. E. 10 Clock rose
 porpoise jumping out soon after
 rose Sperm Whaler amongst them
 going to S. by W. 11 Clock lowered
 Boat. Struck but one whale
 3 Clock came on board cut in
 the whale with 2 plants of
 Rein So Ends Ball 23.30
 Long 59.24

Mon May 17th 1880
 Commenced Light air from N. W
 and wind veering to North with
 frequent showers 2 Clock AM
 Got Works going East port
 wind N. E. heading to North
 Still trying out So Ends
 Ball 23.14
 Long 59.38

Tu May 18th 1880
 Commenced Light breeze from N. E
 East port finished Stowing Down
 22 bls. which makes us 800 Sperm
 So Ends

Wed May 19th 1880
 Commenced Gentle breeze from N. E
 Middle and East port the same
 Ball 25.44
 Long 60.19

On the Western Ground 1880

Th May 20th 1880
 Commenced Gentle breeze from N. E
 Middle and East port the
 same So Ends Ball 27.26
 Long 60.51

Fr May 21st 1880
 Commenced Gentle breeze from N. E
 Middle and East port the
 same in a number still
 So Ends Ball 28.56
 Long 61.06

Sa May 22th 1880
 Commenced Very Light air from
 N. E. by N. West on board of
 Bark C. Webster of Portland
 Bound to Boston Sent Letter
 three days previous had seen
 Sperm whaler in Ball 26.00
 Long 58.00 they were going
 to South So Ends Ball 28.55

Su May 23th 1880
 Commenced Light air and Squally
 from East Middle and East port
 the same So Ends Ball 29.24
 Long 61.15

Mon May 24th 1880
 Commenced Light air from Calmes
 Middle and East port the
 same So Ends Ball 29.06
 Long 61.02
