

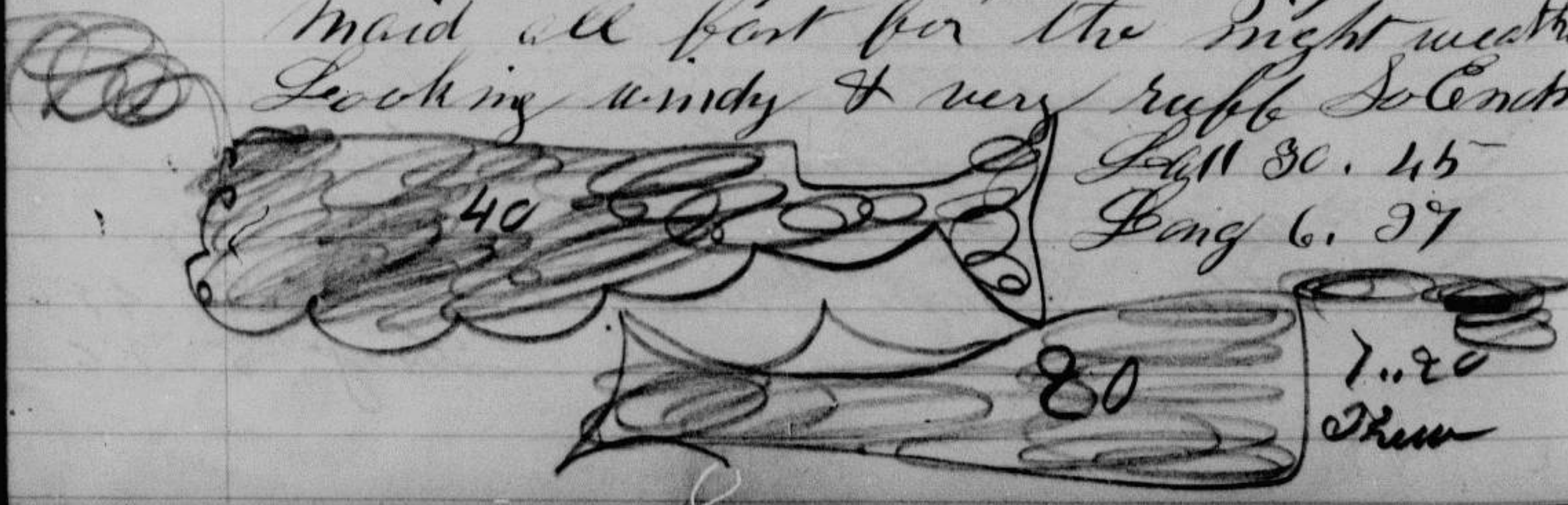

up set every thing & loaded Dicks
& Hove Blubber in 16 o'clock
were ship & the old woman thought
it dangerous to keep working
going East part wind S. S. E.
Still trying
