Wed Sept 6th
Commenced Light air from S. E.
with passing Squels & Brisk Breeze
11 Clock Rose the whale Loured
& the boat went on with the
whale wing round Did not get
near a nuff to strike at 10 Clock
Second mist Struck & fine ported
the whale seemed to be hurt
But could not get far ahead.

I think we oughty of had the

So Ends

Commenced Light air from S. S. E.
Middle & East port the same
Daylight run of to West zig
zag tacked & re tacked see
nothing in porpoise Grampus &
Steamer & a number of seals
Lat 38.02
Long 22.44

Th Nov 9th 1882
Commenced Light air from S. E.
Middle & East port the same
Crossed the same to Day &
in Blackfish & on sail
South 00.13
Long 24.25

Fr Nov 10th 1882
Commenced Brisk Breeze from S. S. E.
Middle & East port the same
Lat 2.00
Long 25.40
