On Dec 16

Commenced Light air from South
Middle & East part the Same
Clock in Sail spoke & gained
Sept Alogone had seen nothing
since leaving Cape De Verde
Had been cruising up in Lat 30.00
Long 9.00 to 11.00 West Lat 30.47
Long 8.42

Su Dec 17

Commenced Light air from S. East
Steering SW by S Dec Alogone &
fin back to Endr Lat 31.36
Long 10.06

Mon Dec 18

Commenced Light air from S. E.
Steering SW by S & Clock in
School Sperm Whaler going to
South Very Moderate Large body
of Whaler scattered over a large
space of Ground 10 o'clock lowered
3 o'clock Long sick with 3 Whaler
Starboard Boat struck 2 Whaler &
Drowed from them both one a
Very Large one Alogone came
in site Lat 32.13
Long 10.16

On Dec 19th 1882

Commenced Light air from S. E.
Middle & East part the Same
Alogone in site in Barker &
cut in the other Whale head
Sail to Endr Lat 32.31
Long 10.24

Wed Dec 20th 1882

Commenced Calm East part
Light air from West & Clock
in School Sperm whaler going
quick to North Large &
Small whaler charged till dark
then came on board to
Endr Lat 32.34
Long 10.20

On Dec 21st

Commenced Gentle Breeze from South
Middle & East part the Same
in Barker Alogone & on Sail
& Clock all through & got
Foreail to Endr Lat 32.28
Long 10.18

On Dec 22nd

Commenced Gentle Breeze from S. E.
Middle & East part the Same
in Barker of Birds & Slicks in
nothing Whaler stand Lat 32.09
Long 10.21
