fine weather

Wednesday march 15
hove up the anchored in morning
looking for whales at 8 A.M.
rise shoal of whales on look
laying at anchored at night

Thursday march 16 1922
Got under way at 5.30 A.M. made
sails and saw whales lowered no
luck returned to San Bay and anchored
fine weather all day and night.

Friday march 17
Got under way at 5.30 A.M. made
sails and saw whales lowered and
did not see whales again saw
school of black fish chased them into
got lost. on after noon rise shoal
whales again and lowered boats and
got one whale small one.
and the mate boatster mined the
whale and went forward and struck
one and line parted. Alfred Scott
and got another boatster John King.

Saturday march 18.
Saw whales did not get near
them fine weather.
