 on San Bay.

Friday March 24 the 1922
 Fine weather got under way at 5:30 A.M.
 and made 4 sails cruising for whales
 on after noon came to anchored. saw nothing
 today.

Sat. March 25 the 1922
 Got under way at 5:30 A.M. and made
 sails on after noon at 1:30 P.M. saw
 school of whales and got one whale
 and got good pictures.

Sunday March 26 the 1922
 Anchored all day working on whale
 on shore fine weather the pictures
 man's working day and night.

Monday March 27 the 1922
 Got under way and made sail
 cruising from whale saw nothing today
 and came to anchored at night.
