

Bark Gay Head

Monday July 23

Calm Ship at anchor off Galapagos island. Saw Whales in sight later Strong breeze from the N. Middle Port the same East Port the same. At 5:30 hove up the anchor and lower two boats. Plenty of Whales in sight but going fast.

Tuesday July 24

Commence with light breeze from the S. Ship standing up towards Panama at 3 p.m. Strong breeze from the N. at 4 p.m. S.B. struck Whale and was fast. Two hours then the iron Draw did not show any chance to kill him. Schooner called Boston boats. Got fast the same the Whale killed the same. East Port Wind N at 5:30 hove anchor and lower two boats. Saw 4 Whales.

Wednesday July 25

Calm later light breeze from the N. at 5 p.m. anchor. Middle Port the same. East Port calm. Did not get under way. Lower two boats employed in staying down. 41 bls 18 gals.

Thursday July 26

Calm later light breeze from the S. Employed in breaking out water at 4 p.m. S.B. struck a Whale and got him. at 11:30 got him a long side. Schooner called Boston anchor. Stearn. Middle Port the same. East Port Wind S and W at 7 o'clock. Lower two boats and commence cutting.

Friday July 27

Calm at 2 p.m. Strong breeze from the N. Ship at anchor. Panama Bay. Employed in cutting up blubber. Schooner boats. Struck a Whale and lost him. Middle Port the same. East Port Wind the same. at 5:30 hove up anchor. Steamed for Perita Bay. Did not see any Whale. Employed in cutting.

Log On Board

Saturday July 28

Light breeze from the N and S. Ship steering towards Perita Bay at Sundown anchor off. Diner Hook employed in killing. Did not see any Whales. Middle the same. East Port Wind N and S at 5:30 hove up anchor and steamed for Perita Bay. Did not see any Whales.

Sunday July 29

Fresh breeze and squally weather from the N and S. Ship working up Perita Bay. Saw six Whales. at Sundown anchor in 12 fathoms. Water. Middle the same. East Port Wind N and S. Did not hove up anchor.

Monday July 30

Light breeze from the S. Ship at anchor. Perita Bay at 1:30 S.B. struck Whale and got him at 7 o'clock. got him a long side. Middle Port the same. East Port Wind N and S at 6:30 lower two boats and commence cutting. Got through at 11 o'clock. 8 eight Whales in the Bay.

Tuesday July 31

Calm later light breeze from the S and N at 4 p.m. W.B. struck Whale and lost him. the iron Draw employed in cutting up blubber at Sundown anchor. Middle Port the same. East Port Wind S. At 5:30 hove up anchor and lower two boats. And stored the works. Sencarl Whales in the Bay.

Wednesday Aug 1

Commence with a calm. With the S.B. fast to a Whale got the Whale along side at 4 o'clock. S.m. and anchor in 20 fathoms. Water good. Many Whales in the Bay. Middle Port Strong from the N. East Port light breeze from the S.W. With heavy rain at 6:30 lower two boats and commence cutting at 11:30. Boats came on board. Could not Whalit to much Rain.
