Tuesday Aug 21

Commence with a light breeze from the S
Later good breeze from the N at 3 p.m.
Raised bow and half lower the S.B. Did not
get her at 5 p.m. took the S.B. whale along
side and anchor Middle Port the same last
Part light breeze from the N at 6 o'clock
Commence cutting Did not see any whales

Wednesday Aug 22

Strong breeze from the S Ship at anchor
Off Cash Rock later fresh breeze from
SW saw one whale employed in cutting
Up blubber Did not lower any boats to
Day Middle Port the same last Part Wind SW
and N at 6 o'clock hove up anchor and lower
two boats Did not see any whales employed
in boiling

Thursday Aug 23

Fresh breeze from the SW Ship running down
towards Sinner Rock Did not see any whales
At 3 p.m. anchor employed in boiling
at 4 p.m. got through boiling Middle Port
the same last Part light breeze from the S
At 6 o'clock hove up anchor and steared
towards Otago saw 5 whales employed in
booping oil and breaking out Shook's

Friday Aug 24

Fresh breeze from the S with rain ball
The boats at three o'clock at 4 p.m. raised
The schooner Calhoun at 7 p.m.
Anchor off Otago in 9 fathoms water
Middle Port the same last Part Wind
N at 6 o'clock hove up anchor lower the
boats at 11 a.m. ship anchor tide running
Too strong saw two whales

Saturday Aug 25

Light breeze from the N Ship at
Anchor off Otago one bow and half
in sight Middle Port the same last Wind NW
At 5 o'clock hove up anchor and stood up to
Otago at 9 a.m. raised bow and half lower
the S.B. Down and struck her at 11 a.m.
Took her along side

Sunday Aug 26

Fresh breeze from the N Ship at anchor
Off Otago at 1 p.m. commence cutting got
through at 4.30 employed in cutting
Up blubber Middle Port the same last
Part Wind N and NW at 6 o'clock lower the
boats Did not get under way employed in
boiling Did not see any whales

Monday Aug 27

Fresh breeze from the N Ship anchor
Off Otago employed in boiling
Middle Port the same last Part light breeze
from the N at 6 o'clock hove up anchor
stood up towards Panama lower the boats
At 9 a.m. raised a very fine whale
S.B. went on and struck got through
boiling at 10 a.m.

Tuesday Aug 28

Commence with a calm at 1.30 took the
S.B. whale along side later strong breeze
from the N at 3 p.m. anchor and
commence staying down Middle Port
the same last Part Wind N and E
later calm at 6 o'clock lower the boats
and commence cutting got through
At 11 o'clock
