out oil

Tuesday Oct 2

Ship at anchor in Panama Employed in
Braking out oil at 11 a.m. took the launch
to Long Side and put 330 Bbls on Board
At 4 p.m. got through 836 Bbls in all.

Log On Board

Wednesday Oct. 3^d 1883

Ship at anchor at Panama. Washing
ship inside and filling up salt casks
water casks. The ship very tender.
at 6 p.m. the crew refused to work
and in trying to put part of them
in iron firearms were used. Gene
Gonsalves & John Baptist each fired
a number of shots from Revolvers.
The Mate fired and wounded
Theophilus Melo. at the same time one
of the crew stabbed the Mate in the
back with a knife. He was taken
below and a boat sent to the steamer
San Blas for a doctor. came back with
Dr. Cwent who staid with him all
night.
