Thursday Oct. 4th

Ship at anchor at Panama. Took Mate, and Theophilus Melo on shore sent Theophilus Melo to the Hospital and Mr. Sullivan to a room and was attended by Dr. Brettleham. Took George Swain from the ship to wait on him, also a Lady Nurse, at 12 o'clock at night boat came from shore with Police and took Gene Gussaloe, & John Baptist the men that used Revolvers and took them on shore to prison.

Friday Oct. 5th

Ship at anchor at Panama. Sent down Royal Guard. The crew on board at work.

Saturday Oct. 6th

Ship at anchor at Panama. Cooper went to Alpinwall to see about the oil.

Sunday Oct. 7th

At anchor at Panama all hands on board except the prisoners & wounded men.

Monday Oct. 8th

At anchor at Panama. The officials from shore came on board and took the depositions from every man on board relating to the late mutiny.

Tuesday Oct. 9th

At anchor at Panama. Commenced setting up shrouks and getting ship ready for sea.

Wednesday Oct. 10th

At anchor at Panama. Setting up shrouks and throwing the ground tier.

Thursday Oct. 11th

Setting up shrouks and throwing them for fresh water.

Friday Oct. 12th

At anchor at Panama. setting up shrouks and throwing cask for water.

Saturday Oct. 13th

At anchor at Panama. setting up shrouks and throwing cask for fresh water. one man deserted name Joe Gloss.

Sunday Oct. 14th

At anchor at Panama. sent a boat on shore to bring Mr. Sullivan on board he being most well.

Monday Oct. 15th

At anchor at Panama. took from the water cask 3400 Gal. water.

Tuesday Oct. 16th

At anchor at Panama. throwing the hold and took on board new provisions. discharged the two prisoners & Theophilus Melo by order of the Consul. also shipped two men. name Antonio Gomez & Joe Williams.

Wednesday Oct. 17th

At anchor at Panama. clearing out and getting ship ready for sea. at 5 P.M. Capt. came on board. ship ready for sea. Joe Williams deserted.
