Wednesday Nov 21

Ship at anchor in turnkey in 3 1/2 fathoms
Water. Capt. of Sail brought on board all of the
Stores Deserted but one. Thomas Harms by name
also received on board 7 men that have shipped
for one year. Ship all ready for sea. at 10 pm
a got under weigh and went to sea

Thursday Nov 22

Middle part under weigh. at 11 P.M. wind
light so anchored. at daylight got under
weigh and stood by the wind to the wind
from N. Starboard part light breeze from N. at 11
A.M. saw a humpback Cow & calf. lowered
L. Boat struck calf & drewed. came on board

Friday Nov 23

Moderate trades heading by the wind to S.
at 3 P.M. tacked to N.W. by foreater. leaving
E dist 5 miles. Middle part strong trades heading by the
wind to N. Starboard part moderate trades heading by the wind to
N.W. at 8 A.M. Japoro Water Towed raised 4 Whales
at 11 A.M. Towed 4 boats and ends chasing the
whales.
