N by N water did not anchor

Monday July 14

Ship Off Old Panama Steaming for
the Pearls Islands Sea Fox in Sight
At 3 p.m. lower two Boats for two
Whales did not get any at Sunset
Anchor in San Maguile Bay gained the Sea Fox
She had taken a Cow and calf 1 Bull Whale
Making about 200 blb

Tuesday July 15

Ship in San Maguile Bay at 8.30 hove up
Anchor and cruised in the Bay Saw 2 Whales
Sea Fox got one at Sunset anchor in
17 fathoms Water at 6.30 had a heavy
Rain Squall

Wednesday July 16

At 5.30 lower ~~two~~ ^{four} Boats at 6 a.m.
Had a heavy rain Squall lasted too hours
At 8 a.m. hove up anchor at 9 a.m. lower
The S.B. Several Whales in Sight at 9.30 S.B.
Struck a Small Bull and got him at 4 p.m.
Took him along Side Capt. Gifford came

Saw 4 Whales to day Sea Fox in Sight

Friday July 18

Ship anchor off Island Chepero at 5.30
lower two Boats and commence Bailing did not
get under way to day Seen two Whales
At 4 p.m. finish Bailing about 15 blb
At Sunset Boats came on Board

Saturday July 19

Ship Anchor off Chepero at 5.30 lower the
S.B. and W.B. at 7 o'clock raised two Whales
From the Ship the S.B. and W.B. lower at
9.30 came on Board again and got under
way at 8 o'clock Steaming from the N with
Bain at 4.30 Boats came on Board at 8 p.m. anchor
Off Chilpelo in 15 fathoms Water

Sunday July 20

Ship Anchor off Chilpelo at 5.30 hove
up anchor at 12 o'clock anchor between
Tobago and Panama at 12.30 Capt and Wife
And mate Went on Shore at Sunset mate
came on Board

Monday July 21

Ship anchor between Tobago and Panama
At 6 o'clock 2 mate Went on Shore for Colors
At 6.30 hove up anchor at 9.30 anchor off
island in 8 fathoms Water at 11.30
Capt came on Board and hove up anchor and
Stood ~~island~~ up to Whar the Steamers lay
