

Port of San Pedro

Friday Aug 29

Ship at anchor off Tabagquilla at 5.30
Hove up anchor and lowered too boats
At 9 a.m. ship anchor off Tabagquilla
To slow down at 4 p.m. finish stowed
down 75 bls at 8.30 boats raised
bow and calf at 9.30 S.B. struck and
got her between Taboga and main land.
Ship did not see the boats when the
struck at 4.30 hove up anchor and
knaped the boats & side off Taboga
Got the whale to the ship at 12 o'clock
the sinking heavy and sharks eating him
could not get him on top water
waited till morning

Saturday Aug 30

Ship at anchor off side off Taboga
5.30 commence working on the whale
At 10.30 got him up so we could
hook on at 12 o'clock finish butting
have about half employed in butting
up blubber and boiling and other duties

Sunday Aug 31

Ship at anchor off Taboga at 5.30 hove
up anchor and lowered too boats at sunset
Anchor off Uogue seen one cow and calf
and three bulls at 8 a.m. finish boiling

Monday Sept 1

Ship at anchor off Uogue at 5.30
Hove up anchor and cleared for liner
rock at 2 p.m. S.B. struck cow and calf
15 miles off liner rock at sunset
Got her along side in a heavy rain
squall anchor in 5 fathoms water

Log on board

Tuesday Sept 2

Ship at anchor off liner rock with
A whale along side at 5.30 lowered too boats
And commence butting at 9 a.m. finish butting
At 5 p.m. raised bow and calf lower the S.B.
Did not get her at sunset boats came
on board seen too cow and calf and several
bulls at 4 p.m. commence boiling

Wednesday Sept 3

Ship at anchor at 5.30 hove up anchor and
lowered the S.B. at 7 a.m. S.B. raised too
whales at 7.30 struck a large cow and got
her along side at 11 a.m. ship anchor 5 miles
off liner rock employed in boiling

Thursday Sept 4

Ship at anchor off liner rock at 5.30
lowered too boats at 7 o'clock hove up anchor
employed in boiling butting up blubber
and breaking out water and stowing down oil
At 2 p.m. anchor and call the boats aboard
had a rain squall from the S.E.
seen 4 whales to day

Friday Sept 5

Ship at anchor off liner rock at 5.30
Hove up anchor and lowered too boats wind
light employed in stowing down at 7 p.m.
boats came on board seen three whales to day
Anchor off liner rock

Saturday Sept 6

Ship at anchor off liner rock at 5.30
Hove up anchor and cleared for Peritabua
lowered too boats at 8 p.m. S.B. raised a
cow and calf and struck her and got
her at dusk got her to the ship in a
rain squall from the S.W. anchor in
the bay
