Monday Oct 13

Strong breeze from the SW Ship heading S. S. S. fore galsail full Bent a new fly jib. water at 9 o'clock. More Ship Middle Port the same East Port Wind the same at 3 o'clock. More Ship at daylight sand in sight at 1 am raised island off Corgona

Tuesday Oct 14

Fresh breeze from the SW Ship on the Starboard tack heading a long the coast. At 1 pm raised the Marthines Beines. At 4 pm gained her Middle Port Wind the same Ship on distant tacks East Port Wind SW with rain nothing in sight

Wednesday Oct 15

Fresh breeze from the W Ship heading S with all sail set East in sight. Employed in mending the jib. Middle Port Wind the same East Wind SW Ship on distant tacks working up the coast sand in sight at 9 am Jose Barreto died with the Dysentery. One of the Stowaways had been sick sent we left Panama

Thursday Oct 16

Strong breeze from the SW Ship on distant tacks working up the coast to lumber. Employed in setting up Shooks at 4 pm Buried Jose Barreto Middle Port Wind the same East Wind the same employed in setting up Shooks and mending the fore top sail. Main top sail one steamer in sight going S.

Friday Oct 17

Fresh breeze from SW Ship on distant tacks working up to lumber at sunset Ship off Esmeralda harbor distant 2 miles. Employed in setting up Shooks Middle and East Wind the same employed in setting up Shooks

Saturday Oct 18

Fresh breeze from the SW Ship on distant tacks working up to lumber Middle and East the same employed in stopping down East and filling them with salt water

Sunday Oct 19

Slight breeze from the SW Ship on distant tacks working up to lumber coast in sight Middle and East Port Wind. S. S. W. Ship and distant tacks schooner in sight beating up the coast

Monday Oct 20

Strong breeze from the S. S. W. Ship beating up the coast and to lumber at sunset. Manta in sight Middle and East Wind the same one schooner in sight employed in setting up Shooks

Tuesday Oct 21

Fresh breeze from the S. S. W. with a strong lee current. Ship on distant tacks beating up to lumber island Plata in sight Middle and East Wind the same employed in setting up Shooks

Wednesday Oct 22

Fresh breeze from the S. S. W. Ship on distant tacks beating up to lumber at 7 pm. Point St Helena light in sight bearing S distant 15 miles Middle and East Wind S. W. Ship on distant tacks one steamer in sight employed in setting up Shooks
