Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack with the head yards a back cutting in at 4 pm finish cutting. Middle part Bailing East part Ship on the Port tack heading S.W. Employed in Bailing and clearing away heads finbacks in sight.

Thursday Nov 27

Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship heading S.W. Under short sail employed in Bailing and clearing away heads Black fish and finbacks in sight. Middle and East part wind the same. Employed in Bailing and breaking out water.

Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Eastward tack under full sail. Employed in Bailing. Stowed down 3 Whales. Middle part Bailing East part Fresh Breeze from S.E. Ship heading E. Employed in Bailing a sail in sight.

Saturday Nov 29

Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack heading E. at 1 o'clock raised a large school Whales going East South West at 2.30 lower 4 boats and struck 5 Whales and 2 W.B. B.B. Middle part saying by the Whales East cutting in Lat 5.17.5

Sunday Nov 30

Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Port tack heading S.W. With top sails foresail jib. Sprinkles employed in Bailing finbacks in sight. Middle part the same East part wind the same at 4 o'clock more ship at 7 o'clock finish Bailing 20 Whales finbacks in sight.

Monday Dec 1

Fresh Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack with top sails foresail jib. Sprinkles Middle part the same East part the same. A sail in sight employed Bailing Whales East the mizen top sail.

Tuesday Dec 2

Slight Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack by the wind heading E.S.E. With top sails and courses under Sprinkles. At 1 o'clock made on board off the Dutch Buis Christian. Brought from arica Bond to Guayaquil. Middle part wind the same East the same.

Wednesday Dec 3

Fresh breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Starboard tack head E.S.E. With all sail at 12 o'clock raised land a head none now cutting eyes. At sunset all topsails head distant 20 miles. Look in the light sails haul up the courses. At 7.30 more ship. Middle part the same East part ship off by star at 11 o'clock hauled. Went ashore to get the chronometers.

Thursday Dec 4

Ship off and on. Part to Capt ashore. At 3 pm came on board with the chronometers. Middle part ship on Port tack heading S.W. East part the same employed in Bailing down. Nothing in sight.
