light breeze from the S. Last the same starboard
head and the rock in sight employed in
tackling and hauling the cable

Tuesday Feb 17

Light breeze from the S. Ship on the Starboard
tack at 1 p.m. tack Ship the rock and starboard
head in sight at 4 o'clock fore ship
Middle Port calm Last Port light breeze
from the S. rock in sight bearing E.S.E.
Sight 10 miles employed in tacking the
cable and painting them

Wednesday Feb 18

Light breeze from the S.W. Ship steering
E and E of S. rock & head in sight
Middle Port light breeze Last Port calm

Thursday Feb 19

from the S. Ship in a tide rip & head
in sight bearing E.S. Sight 20 miles

Middle and Last the same starboard head in sight

Sunday Feb 22

Light breeze from the S. Ship on the Starboard
tack heading E.S.E. Ship in a tide rip
N. head in sight Middle Port calm
Last Port light air from the South nothing
in sight Lat 50.00
Long 91.56

Monday Feb 23

Light breeze from the S.W. Ship on the Starboard
tack heading S.E. all sail set nothing in sight
Middle Port calm Last Port light breeze from
S.W. Ship heading S.E. N. head in sight seen
School of seals

Tuesday Feb 24

Light breeze from the S.W. Ship on the Starboard
tack heading S.E. the rock & head in sight
bearing E.S.E. Sight 20 miles later at 9
o'clock wore Ship Middle Port the same
Last Port wind light and squally N. head in
sight at 9 a.m. raised blackfish lower to
boats did not get any
