Barb. Day Head

Saturday May 2

Commence with a light air from the S.E. later
calm. During the foggy day at 9 o'clock
got through gaining Middle Port good breeze
from the eastward. Last Part the same
N. head Harbor in sight. Seen School Blackfish.

Sunday May 3

Commence with a calm later light breeze from
eastward. Ship heading S.E. Logoda in sight
N. head Harbor in sight. At sunset raised ship to
eastward. Middle Port wind the same. Last Part
light air from eastward at 8 o'clock. Same as the
[Logoda]

Monday May 4

Light breeze from the eastward. Ship on the
Port tack by the wind gaining the Logoda at 1 o'clock.
Raised School. 4 whales lowered 4 boats.
And mated with the Logoda. 10 got one.
And the Logoda 10 got one. Whales going quiet up
to the rock. N. head Bore 6. E. wind 30 miles.
Day Head took South Whales a long side.
Middle Port by the wind on Port tack. Last Part
foggy calm at 5.30. Commence cutting at 8 o'clock.
Finish at 9.30. Fog cleared up. Capt Lewis
came on board. Received 3 barrels to cut
this oil in. Employed in clearing away
heads.

Tuesday May 5

Light breeze from the S.W. Ship steering S.E.
N. head Harbor in sight. Employed in boiling
the blubber and boiling Middle Port calm.
Last Part light air from S. Logoda in sight.
N. head Harbor in sight. S. head in sight. Employed
in boiling.

Wednesday May 6

Light air from the westward. Ship steering S.
Employed in boiling. Logoda in sight at sunset.
Ship off Harbor. Current 15 miles. Middle
Port light breeze from S. Last light air from S. and E.
Logoda in sight. N. head Harbor in sight at 9.30.
Finish boiling. Turn up 50 lbs.

Thursday May 7

Light breeze from the S. Ship on the Port tack.
At 1.30 pm gave the Logoda her share off the oil.
25 lbs. Later gaining at 9 o'clock. Capt came on board.
Middle Port calm. Last Part light air from eastward.
And thick fog.

Friday May 8

Commence with a calm and thick fog at 2 pm. Clear
the Logoda and Harbor in sight. Later light
breeze from S.E. Ship steering S.E. S.
Middle and Last Part calm. Logoda N. head Harbor in
sight. Employed in staying down 25 lbs.

Saturday May 9

Calm at 2 pm. Light breeze from S.W. later
calm. Middle Port calm. Last Part light air
from S.E. with thick fog.
