Tuesday June 23

Light breeze from the Southward Ship Stearing  
E at 1.30 am finish Bailing turn up 55 lbs  
Later Ship Stearing N.E. Middle Port Laying  
A back Last Port Stearing for manna at 8.30  
Capt went on shore to get letters Lower  
The L.B. & W. Boat for humpbacks did not  
Get any Ten Seal Whales at 12 o'clock Capt  
came on board

Wednesday June 24

Fresh breeze from Southward Ship on  
The Port Tack at 8.30 Cleared up for  
Suer later Stearing N.E. Middle Port  
And Last the same Employed in Staying  
Down oil 58 lbs & 17 gals

Thursday June 25

Fresh breeze from the Southward Ship Stearing  
for Suer at 7 p.m. anchor 10 fathoms water  
Between Port galera of Suer Middle Port the same  
Last Port at 8 am head up anchor at 11 am  
Anchor in Suer in 3 fathoms water

Friday June 26

Ship at anchor in Suer Received 4 barrels  
Wood on board and took a raft off back  
Ashore for water

Saturday June 27

Ship at anchor in Suer Received 20 barrels  
Loose Wood & 30 lbs water took a raft ashore

Sunday June 28

Ship at anchor in Suer in 4 fathoms water  
Crew ashore for water. Three men Deserted  
Got a raft water on board 114 lbs

Monday June 29

Ship at anchor in Suer Employed in  
Staying water Received three barrels Wood 11 barrels  
All told

Tuesday June 30

Ship at anchor in Suer Employed in  
Setting up the fore gal back stays and  
Washing Ship in Tide

Wednesday July 1

Ship at anchor in Suer Received fruit  
on board and two new men and a boy  
Names Juan Bautista Andrades.
