Thursday Sept 3

Strong breeze from the S.E. employed in cutting last 5 in Middle Port Laying by the Whales under Short Sail started work last Port cutting up blubber clearing head and commence cutting

Friday Sept 4

Fresh breeze from the S.E. employed in cutting at 2.30 finish clearing away heads cutting up blubber boiling Middle Port ship on the Westward tack under Short sail last The same employed in cutting up blubber clearing away heads boiling
