Fresh Breeze and foggy weather from the Southward Ship on the Starboard tack. Later raining. Middle part the same at 1 o'clock haul the head yards a back. Last part clear weather at 5 am brace full Sea Fox. I. head and harbor in sight. Plenty off pinbacks in sight. Employed in flagging back and braking out the lumber back.

Wednesday Sept 16

Strong Breeze from the S.E. in fog squalls. Ship on the Starboard tack heaving to. Sea Fox South head harbor in sight. At sunset shorting sail and wore ship. Middle part wind the same at 1 o'clock wore ship. Last part wind the same. Ship off. I. head. Stearing chipent courses. Plenty off pinbacks in sight and sulphur bottoms.

Thursday Sept 17

Strong Breeze from the S.E. Ship off harbor. Stearing chipent courses. At sunset shorting sail. Ship on the Port tack. Middle part the same. Last the same. Pinbacks in sight. Employed in mending the fore sail.

Friday Sept 18

Strong Breeze from the S.E. Ship on the Port tack by the wind with topsails courses. Gills and Spanker. Seen pinbacks at 4.30. Wore ship. Middle part the same. Last part wind the same. Ship off harbor. Stearing chipent courses. Pinbacks and sulphur bottoms in sight. South head and I. head in sight. Employed in mending the upper main topsail.

Strong Breeze from the S.E. Ship off harbor. Stearing chipent courses. Later Ship on the Port tack by the wind under short sail. Middle part the same. Last part Strong Breeze in fog squalls. Employed in mending the upper fore topsail. Seen plenty sulphur bottoms and pinbacks.

Sunday Sept 20

Strong Breeze from the Southward in fog squalls. Ship on the Eastward tack with topsails courses. Middle part the same. Last part wind the same with fog squalls. Seen several pinbacks.

Fresh Breeze from the Southward Ship. Off I. head on chipent tacks. Seen several sulphur bottoms. Middle part the same. Last part wind light. Ship on the Eastward tack. South head harbor. North head N.E. Point in sight and sulphur bottoms.

Light Breeze from the Southward Ship. Off I. head on chipent tacks. Middle part the same. Last part the same. Plenty off sulphur bottoms in sight.
