Light Breeze from the S.S. Ship on the Western Tack heading W. nothing in Sight. Middle and Last Ship steering W. Seen nothing.

Light Breeze from the S.S. Ship Steaming W. nothing in Sight at Sunset Shorting Sail. Middle Part the same. Last Part Wind the same. At Daylight made sail.

Fresh Breeze from the S.S. Ship on the Eastern Tack nothing in Sight. Middle and Last Wind the same. Seen several finbacks. Employed in Repairing the mainsail.

Wednesday June 2

Fresh Breeze from the S.S. Ship on the Eastern Tack by the wind Repairing the mainsail at 4 pm. Bent it. Several finbacks in Sight. Middle Part Supply with light rain. Last fresh Breeze Ship Steaming E by S.

Thursday June 3

Long 84 54 W

Fresh Breeze from the S.S. Ship Steaming E by S. At 3 pm by the wind heading S.E. by E. Employed in mending the fifth on bent the fore-top-tail sail. At 5 pm raised a large whale going to windward. Lower the boats to late to do anything. Middle Part Ship on the Eastern Tack at 3 o'clock tack Ship. Last Part fresh Breeze at 4 am tack Ship. Several finbacks in Sight. Lat 00 25 N Long 84 36 W
