At 5.30 hove up anchor and Lower too

Thursday Sept 2

At 5.30 hove up anchor and Lower too Boats
At 12.30 S. Boat struck bow & half at 2.30
But Whale dead Layed by the Whale all
night ship could not get to whale at daylight
Sharks set the irons out

Friday Sept 3

Ship at anchor at the mouth Perista Bay
In 20 fathoms water employed in staying
Down

Saturday Sept 4

At 5.30 hove up anchor at 9 am Lower too
Boats seen no Whales to day at Sunset anchor
At head off Bay.

Sunday Sept 5

At 5.30 hove up anchor and Lower too Boats
At Sunset anchor off liner rock seen three
Bulls and one bow & half

Monday Sept 6

At 5.30 Lower too Boats at 10 am hove up
Anchor at 3 pm ball Boats on Board
Since up humpbacking later fresh breeze
From the N.E. ship steering S.E. by S

Tuesday Sept 7

Commence with light wind from Westward with
Rain ship on the Eastern tack employed
In washing ship

Light breeze from the Southward ship on
The Port tack S.W. by W. & W.S.W. at 2 pm
Took ship the later ship heading S by E
Middle Port Wind light East Port fresh breeze
From the N.W. in Rain squalls ship on the

Later light breeze from Southward ship on
The Western tack heading N by N. Middle Port
Ship on Eastern tack heading S by S and S.E.
East Port heading S by E Wind light Lat 4 34 N
Long 87 27 W

Saturday Sept 11

Light breeze from the Westward ship on the

S by S and S.E. at 11 am were ship
employed in washing forecathle Lat 3 55 S
Long 78 31 W

Sunday Sept 12

Commence with a light breeze from the Westward
Ship on the Southern tack heading S by S by W
Later strong breeze Middle and East Wind
The same ship on Sifted tacks at daylight
Raided Island Gorgona

Monday Sept 13

Strong breeze from the N.W. ship on Sifted
Tacks beating up too Inga for a galsail for
Middle Port and East the same Gorgona in
sight employed in braking out water

Tuesday Sept 14

Fresh breeze from the Westward ship on
Sifted tacks working up to Inga
employed in mending galsail Island
Gorgona in sight Middle and East the same
