wind from N.E. Lat 36.40 Long 53.51

Thursday Jan 18th 78

Comm. with strong wind from N.E. &
very humped see. a gam. of bright whales
passed & struck. see. got 2 cows & 1 light
by stone at 7 PM got the whale to the

Cruising off Rio De la Plater

Ship. so much wind & sea. it was blown
before we got him. got. see. a whaling barque
Mid & Lath. Part. strong wind & very humped

begins with a gale from N.E. to N.E. at 4 PM. humped
Ship. head N.E. Mid & Lath. Part. the same
at. with rain.
