Moderate trades from S.W. by S. sea. fish & smoking
on shore. Lat. 22.35 Long 165.40

Thursday Aug 13th 1012
Fresh trades S. to the N.W. Land Sat 20 M. Sat
at 11 AM left the ship to land on the island

Friday Aug 14th 1013
Fresh trades at 6 AM got on board with a
few yams. Lat. 20.41 Long 163.22

Saturday Aug 15th 1014
Moderate trades S. W. W. Lat. 19.50 Long 161.52

Sunday Aug 16th 1015
Fresh trades from East. S. North. the Minerva in
camp. Lat. 16.38 Lat. Long 162.07 E

Monday Aug 17th 1016
Fresh trades from East. S. W. W.
Lat. 13.56 Long 162.16

Tuesday Aug 18th 1017
Fresh trades from East. Lat. East. squally
Lat. 11.29 Lat. Long 161.38 E

Wednesday Aug 19th 1018
Fresh trades & squally at 2 PM see the Island of
St. Christoval. at 6 PM lay off Markela bay
Lat. Strong trades

Thursday Aug 20th 1019
Strong trades at 6 PM lay off & on Markela the wind
light from the land.

Friday Aug 21th 1020
Light air & calm. Hauled the ship in to the
harbour of Markela to anchor. Struck two diff.
times on the coral rocks. No damage done to
the ship as I can perceive. Lat. part getting
wood & water. Load 4 days before by the Minerva

Saturday Aug 22th 1021
Getting wood & water & tracking for yams

Sunday Aug 23th 1022
Leave on Liberty. No ship duty performed

Markela bay - Is. of St. Christoval.

Monday Aug 24th 1023
Many Markela of hair. camp in getting wood &
water & tracking for recruits

Tuesday Aug 25th 1024
Morning & tracking

Wednesday Aug 26th 1025
Morning & painting ship.

Painting & tracking

Camp in taking baggage &c

Saturday Aug 29th 1028
Fresh breeze took up the anchor & cleared the
camp in various jobs of boat duty

Fresh trades all this day. the ship ready for sea
George Green & Chilian Green boarded

Monday Aug 31th 1030
Ready for sea. awaiting to catch hurricanes
brought by Green to sea

Tuesday Sept. 1st 1031
Trades all this day hope to get out to sea

Wednesday 2nd 1032
Cloudy & rainy weather.

Thursday 3rd
Cloudy & some rain. At 6 PM got under
way & towed out of Markela bay in company
with the Minerva. Lat. East. Strong wind &
squally No Ob

Friday Sept. 4th 1034
Strong wind from S.W. headed to the south. Sea
& wind top sails in. Lat. East. off Russell Is.

Saturday Sept. 5th 1035
Fresh trades & clearing. cruising off & on Russell Is.
Lat. East. squally of rain. No prospect to be
get on Russell Is. there being but few inhabitants
